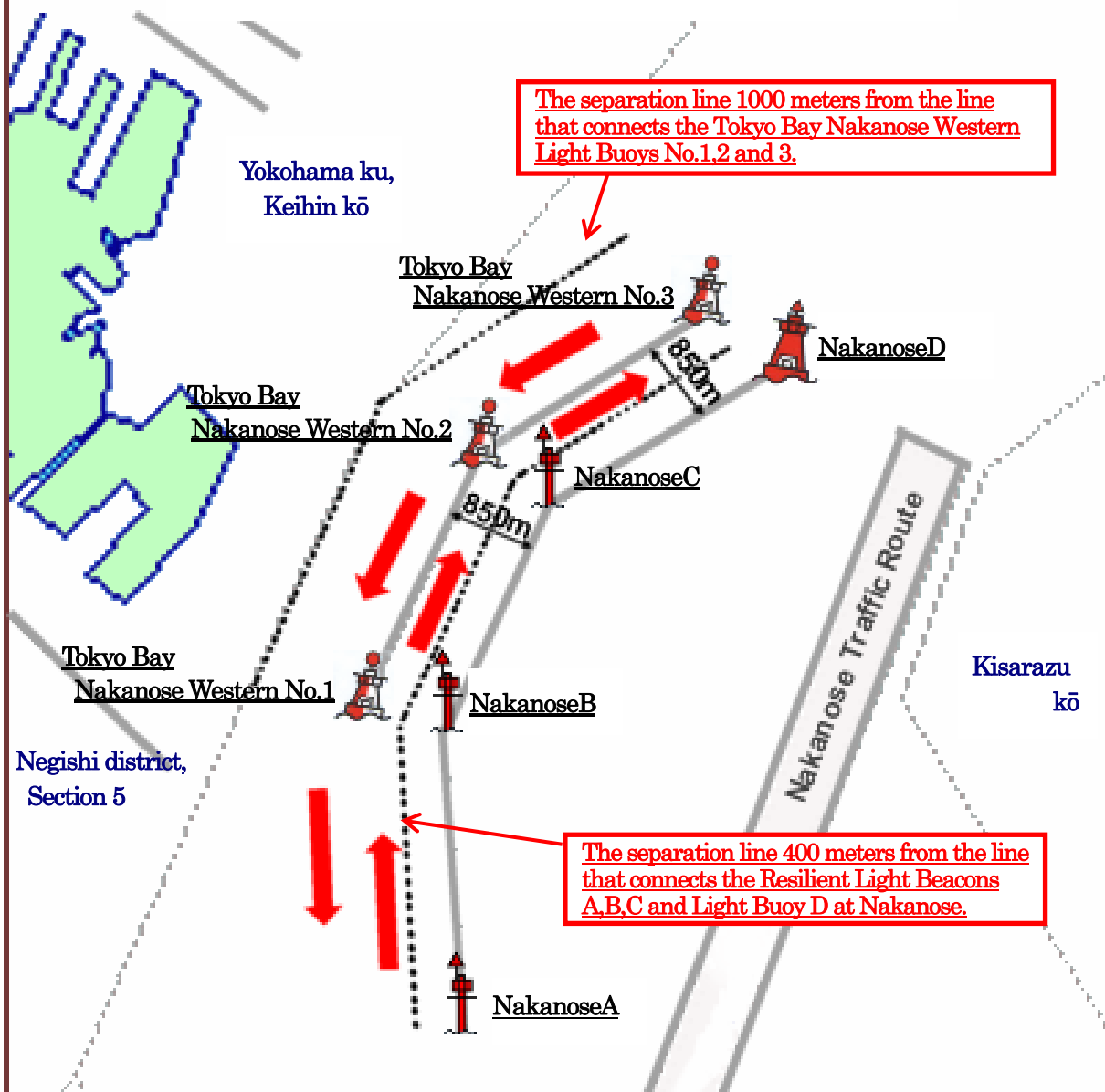


On Navigation in Nakanose West Zone



Navigation in the Western Area of Nakanose in Tokyo Bay

1. Southbound vessels sailing through the western area of Nakanose in Tokyo Bay should pass the Tokyo Bay Nakanose Western Light buoys No.3,2 and 1 (referred to as the separation light buoys hereafter) on their port side.
2. Northbound vessels sailing through the western area of Nakanose in Tokyo Bay, except for those heading for Negishi, section 5, Yokohama ku, Keihin Kō, should pass the separation light buoys on their port side until they have set their designated course to their destination.
3. Northbound vessels of 17-meter draft and over sailing through the western area of Nakanose in Tokyo Bay should pass at a distance of at least 400 meters from the line that connects the Resilient Light Beacons A,B,C and Lights Buoys D placed at Nakanose in Tokyo Bay.
4. Vessels wishing to anchor in the western area of Nakanose in Tokyo Bay should do so at a distance of at least 1,000 meters from the line that connects each of the separation light buoys.
